American Immigration Council -Fact Sheet: Immigrants in Washington-2017

- 980,000 immigrants
- 1 in 7 Washington residents is an immigrant
- 1 in 8 is a native-born citizen w/imm-born parent
- 350,000 people in WA live with at least one undocumented family member
- 16,000 DACA recipients another 17,000 eligible
- 1 in 6 workers in Washington is an immigrant

Enhancing Public Safety in the Interior of the U.S.

January 25, 2017, Executive Order announced a

massive expansion in <u>interior</u> enforcement. The

order defines enforcement priorities extremely

broadly, <u>placing all unauthorized individuals at</u>

risk of deportation, including families & long-

time residents.

Previous Enforcement Priorities

- Engaged in terrorist activities
- Felons
- 3 + significant misdemeanors
- Significant misdemeanor: DUI, DV,
 - Burglary
- Criminal gang activity

Current Removal Priorities

Effective immediately, DHS shall faithfully execute US immigration laws against "all removable" individuals and will no longer exempt classes, or categories of people, from enforcement.

Examples of Policy Shifts

Immigration Court - Numerical quotas and curtailing procedural safeguards

Education Secretary - Individual schools can decide if they wish to report their undocumented students to ICE

<u>Temporary Protected Status</u> - 300,000 lawfully present individuals must depart voluntarily or face deportation

Expanded Ground of Inadmissibility - Public charge

Parents and Children - Separated at border
